

College Savings Mississippi Savings Shootout
NO PURCHASE NECESSARY TO ENTER TO WIN. VOID WHERE PROHIBITED

CONTEST DESCRIPTION AND TIMING: The 2015 College Savings Mississippi Savings Shootout (the “Contest”) will be held at the MSHAA State Basketball Championships on March 13,2015. For the contest, a select number of Mississippi residents will be chosen to participate by shooting and making a specified number of free throw shots. Parents of legal guardians must complete the entry sheet for any person under the age of 18 wishing to partake in the contest.

CONTEST SPONSOR AND ADMINISTRATOR: College Savings Mississippi (the “Sponsor”), 501 North West Street, Suite 1101, Jackson, MS 39201; 601-359-5255.

ELIGIBILITY: The Contest is open to any Mississippi resident attending the MSHAA State Basketball Championships on March 13,2015. Members of the immediate family of employees of the Mississippi Office of the State Treasurer are not eligible.

HOW TO ENTER: To enter the Contest, Mississippi residents (“Entrants”) must –

For those under the age of 18 –

1) HAVE A PARENT OR LEGAL GUARDIAN COMPLETE OFFICIAL REGISTRATION: information and entry sheet available at the Contest registration and information table. Registration must be completed and signed by Entrant’s parent or legal guardian prior to selection and competition 2) ENTRANTS AND PARENT OR LEGAL GUARDIAN MUST BE PRESENT AT TIME OF ASSEMBLY AND COMPETITION. Parent or legal guardian must accompany participant under the age of 18.

For those 18 years of age and older –

1) COMPLETE OFFICIAL REGISTRATION: information and entry sheet available at the Contest registration and information table. Registration must be completed and signed by Entrant prior to selection and competition. 2) ENTRANTS MUST BE PRESENT AT TIME OF ASSEMBLY AND COMPETITION.

LIMIT: One (1) contestant per immediate family during the Contest period. In the event more than one (1) contestant in said immediate family is selected, the first contestant chosen will be considered the only valid contestant for said family and a replacement for the second contestant will be chosen.

CONTESTANT SELECTION: Entrants residing in Mississippi will be selected at random by a College Savings Mississippi Representative. The selected contestants will be notified by phone prior to the competition and must be present 30 minutes prior to the start of the competition. Any selected contestant who does not confirm his/her participation by answering his/her phone at the time of contact will be considered void and another contestant will be chosen. Participants understand if chosen they will be required to shoot free throws at Mississippi High School regulation goal height.

CONTEST RULES: Only two (2) contestants will be chosen to compete in the Contest. Both contestants will have one (1) minute to make as many free throws as possible. The contestant with the most shots made at the end of the minute will be declared the winner of the contest. Upon the event of a tie each contestant will have a chance to shoot an additional free throw shot until one makes a shot and the other misses; the contestant with the made basket will be declared the winner of the contest.

WINNER SELECTION/VERIFICATION: Winner will be at the conclusion of the contest. . If the selected winner does not meet the eligibility requirements, he or she will be disqualified. The winner, or the parent or legal guardian of

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the winner if under age 18, will be required to complete, execute and return within a specified time an Affidavit of Eligibility, Publicity Release and MACS application or the Prize (defined below) will be forfeited and awarded to the alternate contestant.

PRIZES / APPROXIMATE RETAIL VALUE (ARV): One (1) prize of \$529.00 will be awarded to the winner of the contest. The prize will be in the form of a MACS Account for the benefit of a child designated by the winner, or the winner himself or herself. The appropriate contract purchaser according to the MACS rules and regulations will be listed as the owner of the account and will be required to fill out the necessary paperwork in order to claim the prize.

GENERAL PRIZE RESTRICTIONS: The parent or legal guardian of the designated beneficiary will be responsible for all federal, state and local taxes, applicable to acceptance and use of the Prize, including income taxes, if any, and will be required to provide his/her Social Security Number or Federal Taxpayer Identification Number for tax reporting purposes. Any and all costs associated with acceptance and use of the Prize will be the sole responsibility of the winner. Sponsor will file an IRS Form 1099 with the Internal Revenue Service for the fair market value of prize. No transfer or substitution of the Prize permitted, except by Sponsors who reserve the right to substitute the Prize, in whole or in part, for one of comparable or greater value.

AGREEMENT TO THE OFFICIAL RULES: By participating in the Contest, each Entrant (and Entrant's parent or legal guardian) fully and unconditionally agrees to and accepts these Official Rules and the decisions of the Sponsor, the judges and the Administrator, which are final and binding in all matters related to the Contest.

RELEASE: By participating, Entrants and their parents or legal guardians agree to release and hold harmless the Contest Entities, and their respective trustees, directors, officers, agents, affiliates and employees (collectively, "Released Parties") from any and all liability for any claims, costs, injuries, losses or damages of any kind caused by their participation in the Contest, including, but not limited to, the unauthorized or illegal access to personally identifiable or sensitive information. All Entries become the property of the Sponsor and will not be acknowledged nor returned under any circumstances. Upon request of Sponsor, Entrant will provide an Affidavit of Eligibility, Publicity Release and MACS application as required above. The winner will grant to Sponsor and its designees the right, except where prohibited by law, to use their and their child's name, age, grade, likenesses, pictures, addresses (cities and states), voices, biographical information, and/or written or oral statements, for advertising, promotional and online voting purposes in promoting the Sponsor, its products, Web-sites, and/or this Contest or succeeding Contest, in any and all media now or hereafter known throughout the world in perpetuity, without additional compensation, notification or permission. Entries not complying with all rules are subject to disqualification.
